## Raksha Bandhan

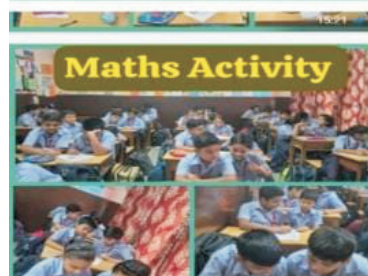
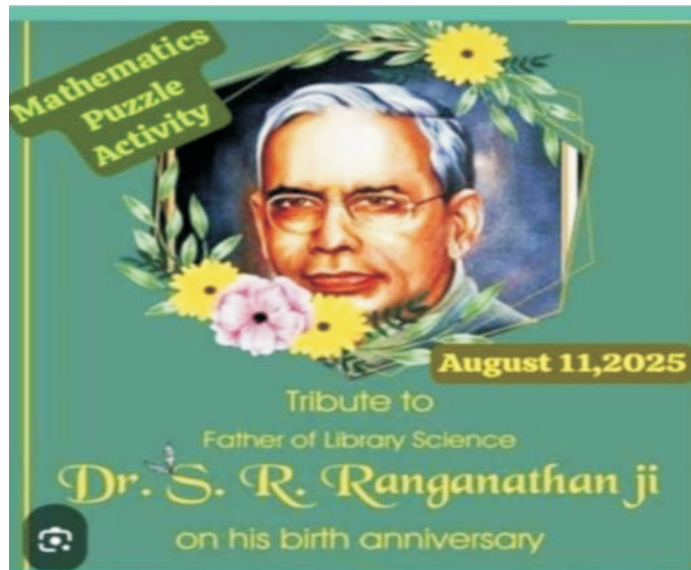
**The paths may change as life goes along, but the bond between a brother and sister remains ever strong.**

### Solo Dance Competition

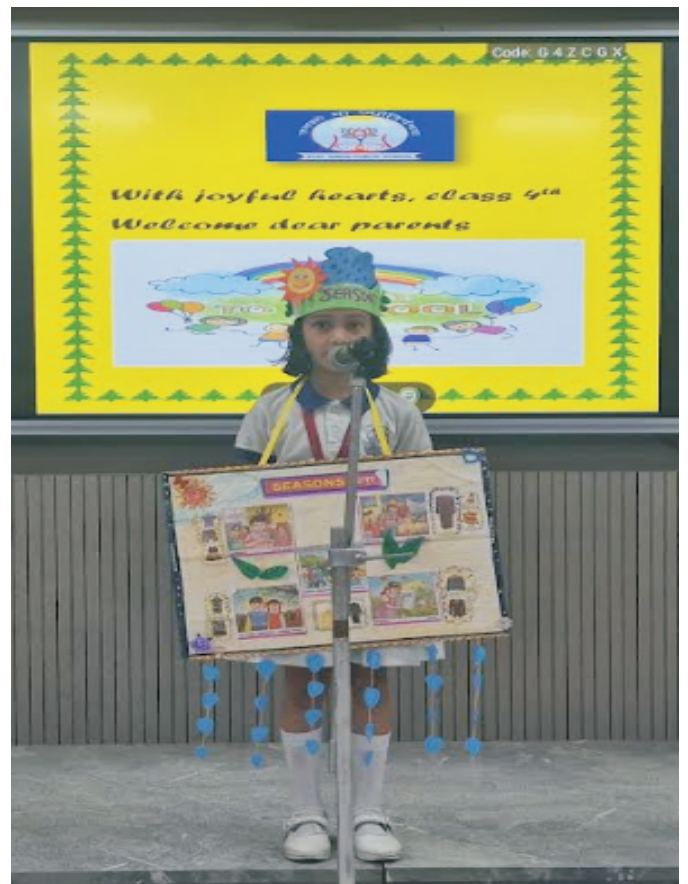
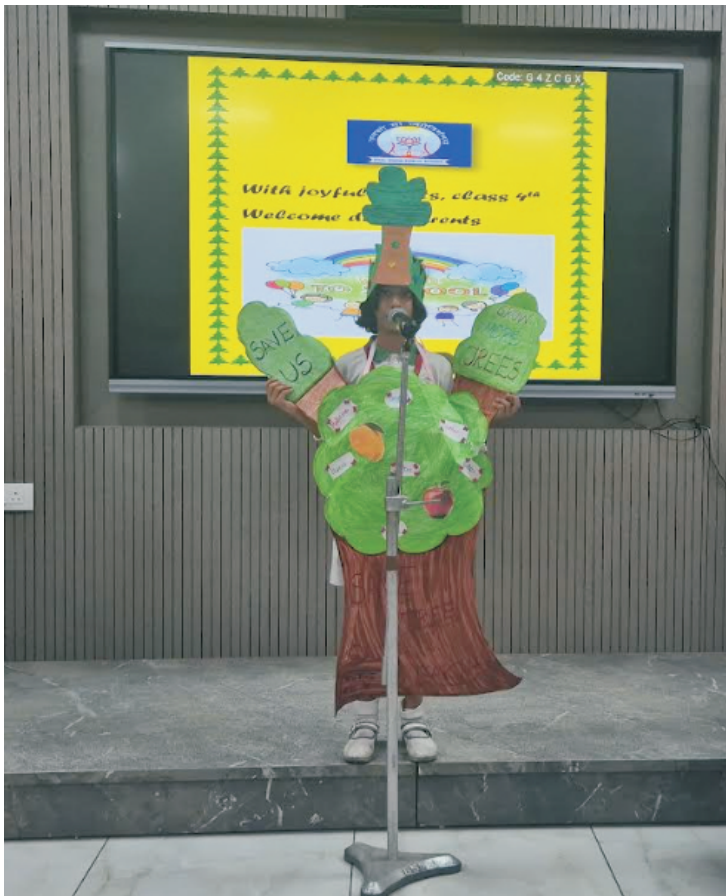

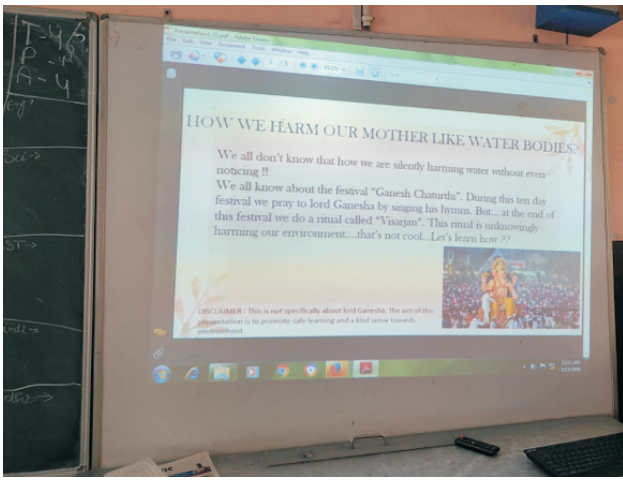




### **Awareness Campaign on Harmful Effects of Use of Plaster of Paris (POP)**

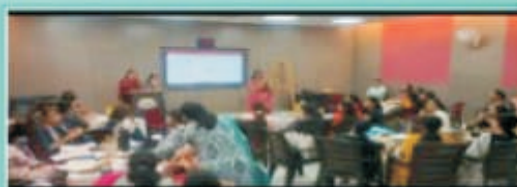

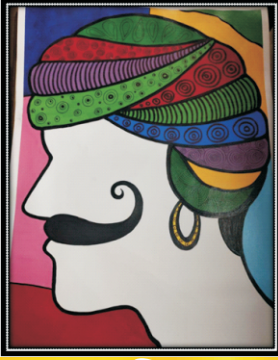
